National EHR: Unified model and nationwide interoperability

Need to codify clinical information

To be done at the point of care

Physicians don't like to be restricted to structured terms

SNOMED CT is the clinical terminology closest to medical reasoning

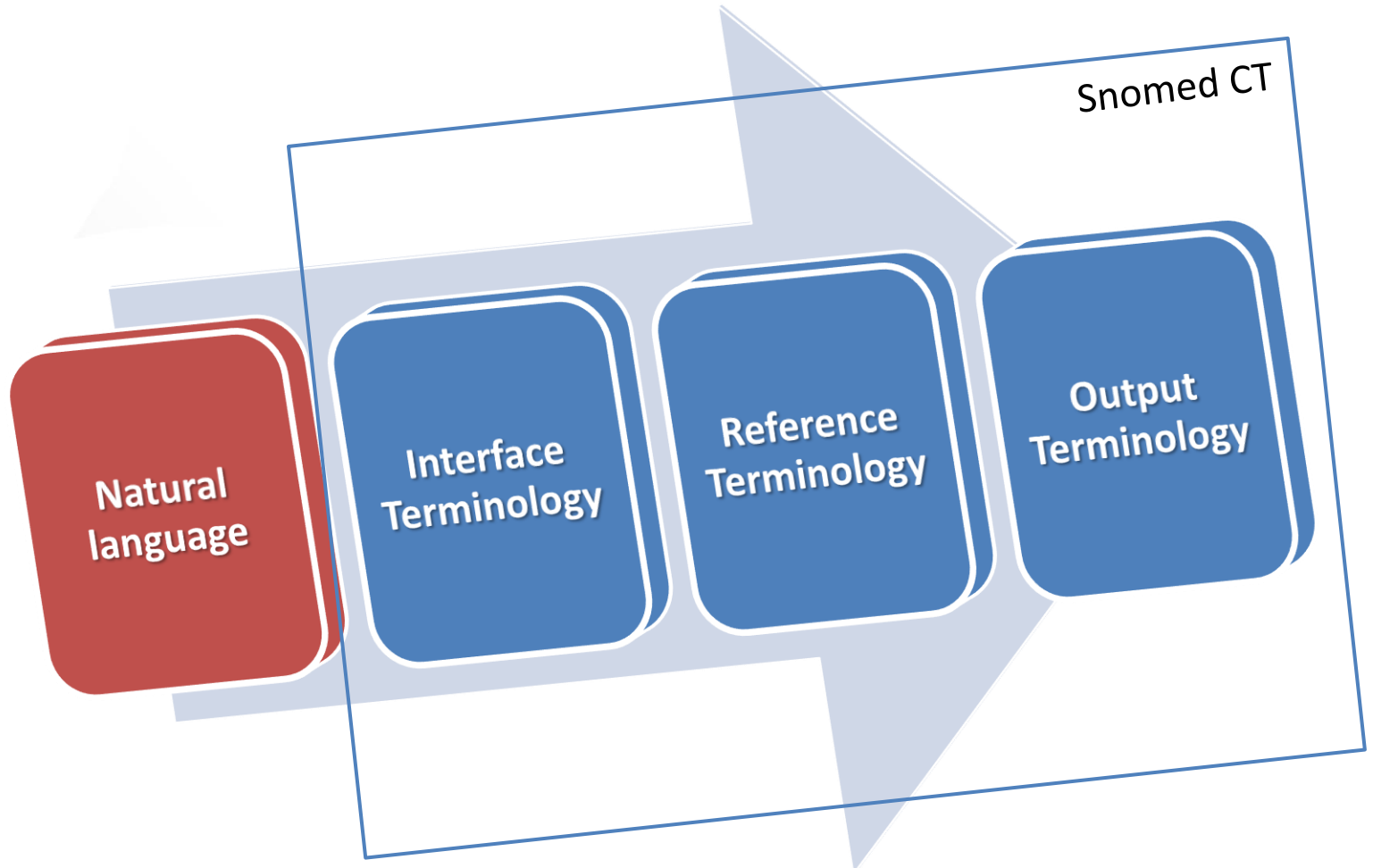
Uruguay has been a member country of IHTSDO since **2012**.

Binding Natural Language Processing (NLP) and SNOMED CT browsing => automatic coding

Coding clinical information in SNOMED CT is an optimal resource for research, evaluation, building health policies and supporting patient safety

 - External expert advisors





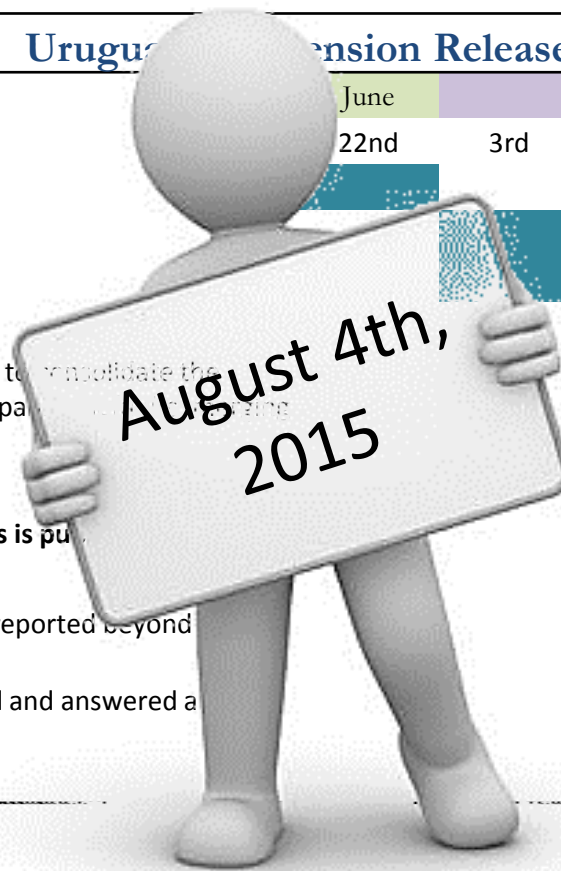

Pre-release development QA			
Release: Data are extracted			
Post-release: Manual steps are undertaken to consolidate the release, such as inclusión of International Spanish terms, and testing with previous versions, etc.			
Release files QA			
Beta release: The beta release for affiliates is published			
Feedback period			
Feedback closure: Issues no longer can be reported beyond date			
Feedback processing: Feedback is reviewed and answered and required changes are made.

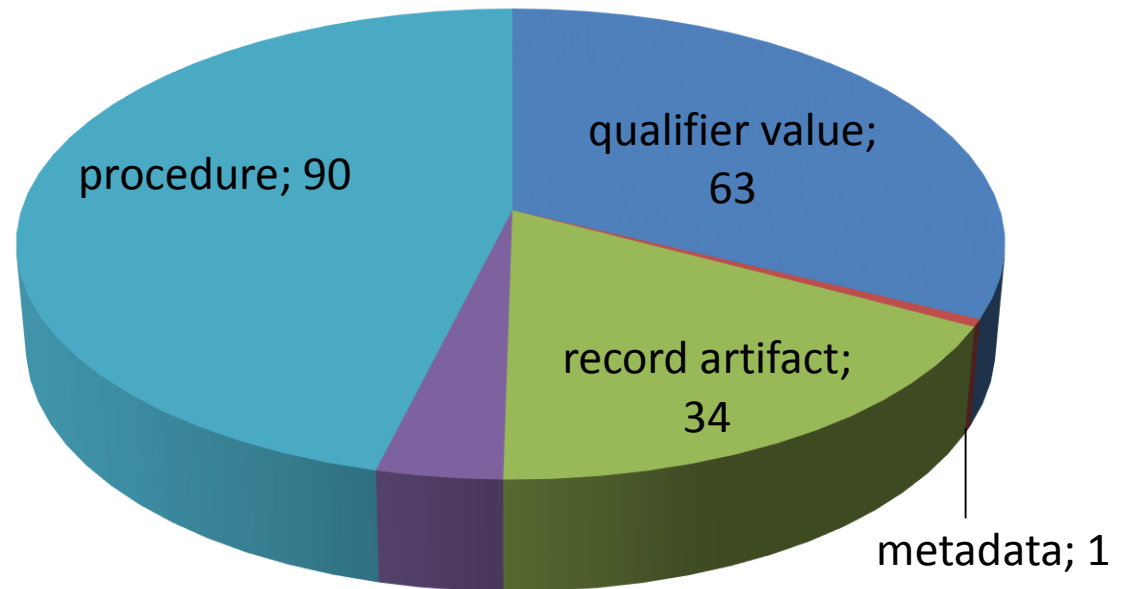

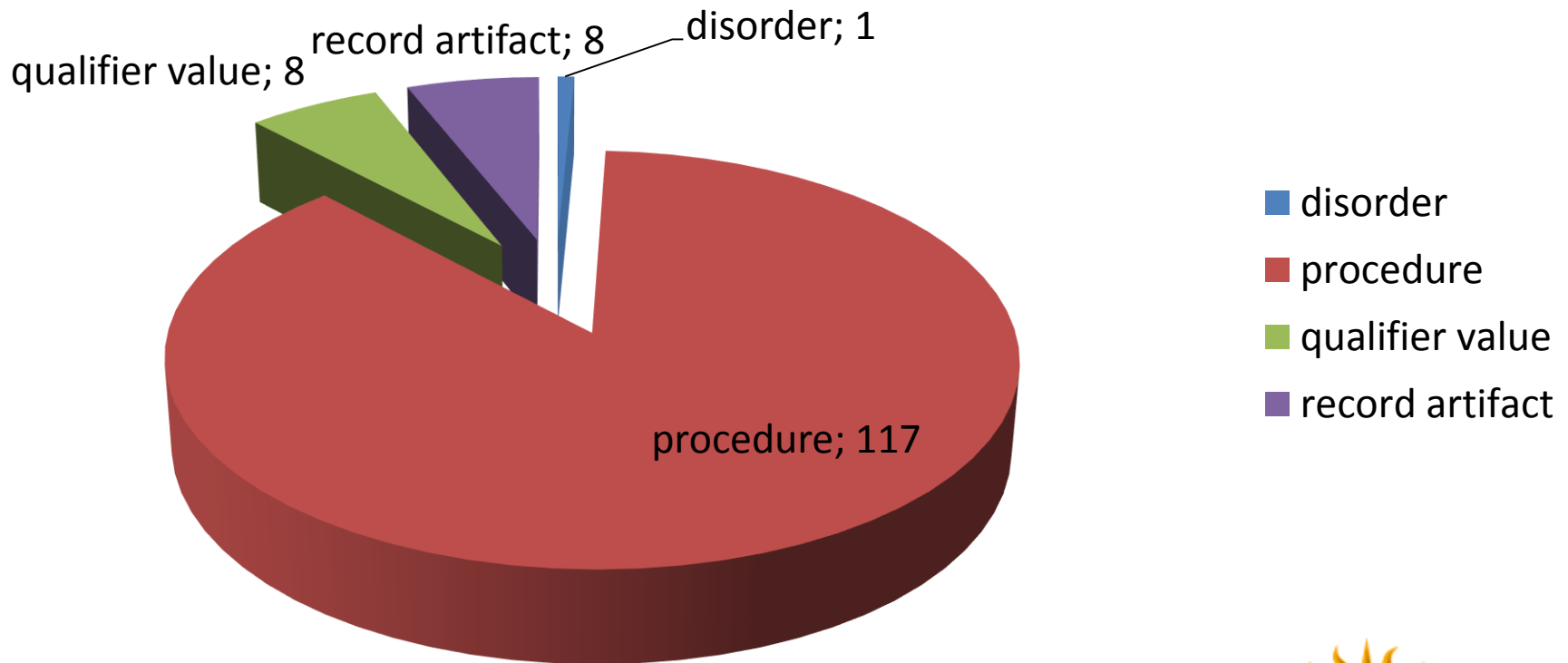
