
- Is an agency within the Ministry of Health of Catalonia.

ICT strategy of the Ministry of Health of Catalonia





- Aims to standardize the controlled vocabulary used in Catalan Health System:
 - Focusing on the exchange of information.
 - Using one single conceptual model.
 - Keeping other vocabularies currently in use.
 - Relating concepts of different domains, sources and representations.




- Is a transversal project of the Ministry of Health of Catalonia:
 - Leaded by the OFSTI.
 - And managed by a permanent commission.
 - Is organized in domains of content, each of them are worked by a **multidisciplinary team** of experts.



- Uses SNOMED CT as reference terminology and ontology of representation:
 - The concepts of each domain are grouped in RefSets.
 - These RefSets are created following a standard methodology developed by the OFSTI.
 - Other controlled vocabularies are mapped to SNOMED CT.
 - All new needed components and mechanisms are created in the Catalan extension.







We have worked on **13 domains** developing near **40 subsets** and creating more than **2500 concepts** of SNOMED CT as part of the Dictionary:

CLINICAL DICTIONARY FOR ISALUT

The Clinical Dictionary for iSalut is a transversal proyect that has the objective to standardize the vocabulary of SISCAT (Integrated Healthcare System of Public Healthcare Network of Catalonia) to achieve the semantic interoperability between information systems of healthcare providers at different care levels. This interoperability guarantees the data exchange without losing its meaning and allows its representation and automatic and unambiguous interpretation. The final aim is to support the decision-making in the care process.

The basis of the dictionary is the clinical terminology SNOMED CT (Systematized Nomenclature of Medicine Clinical Terms). This standard acts as an ontology, offering an homogeneous base to represent the knowledge. The dictionary contains also other controlled vocabularies which are nowadays used in the SISCAT, both international and local (such as ICD-9-CM, ICD-10, ISCO/CNO, LOINC, etc.), but most of them are mapped to SNOMED CT to ensure semantic interoperability of contents. The dictionary is conformed by different domains that are worked as subsets of SNOMED CT, following the methodology of creating subsets of SNOMED CT defined by CCI and the OFSTI (Office of Standards and Interoperability) of TicSalut.

The Clinical Dictionary for iSalut is managed by a permanent commission that marks the lines of action to follow and the priorities. Each domain is worked by a multidisciplinary team of experts of the Catalan Health System. Thus, the dictionary includes the participation of health care professionals from different centres, programs and institutions. The list of contributors can be found in the domains documentation.

- Is managed and distributed by the OFSTI.
- Has the namespace 1000135.
- The current version is the 5th (30-9-2015).
- Includes simplified Excels with subsets and documentation (guides and memories).




The Catalan extension

Is distributed in RF1 format:

- Has its own history mechanism.
- New descriptions are created in Spanish and we are working with our NRC to translate it into Catalan.
- The main subsets are groups of concepts but we have made subsets of descriptions to indicate preferred descriptions.
