

**Topic-based webinars** 

Belgium: Developer Training Day (Nov 2021 - Primary care/refset impl.). 'Ad hoc' project related training on request.

**Argentina:** Making changes in traditional Standard's Mornings. Made a survey asking for the most relevant topics that SNOMED CT users want to approach and planning this year training based on that demand.

Netherlands: Planning new training on implementation, mostly for software developers.

• Done this in the past. What's new? - have a national terminology server, all SNOMED concepts that are relevant for the Netherlands are translated, and we have more 'best practices' to share.

Australia: Refreshing website, creating more engaging content about SNOMED CT and the National Clinical Termonology Service (NCTS)

Recommendations (do's and don'ts)? How to identify topics? How to engage stakeholders?

Terminologist training

Netherlands: Working on an education plan for training terminologists (Plan almost ready).

- Can work outside of NRC, similar to the plan of SNOMED International.
- The reason for this is that they get a lot of requests to help with mappings or making reference sets, but that leaves less room for them to focus on innovation and implementation support.
- It could be valuable to exchange experiences about this!

#### Personalized training

Netherlands: Online escape room - 4 challenges (Almost ready to release).

Participants get to know the problems that can be solved using SNOMED CT and how it can help health care professionals in their daily work.

- e.g. semantic interoperability and why SNOMED CT adds value with its polyhierarchy.
- Last challenge they have to make a selection of patients who should get a preventive treatment for a new disease, by making use of the SNOMED CT hierarchy.
- Main target group is health care professionals, also medical informaticists or software developers.

Translation of courses

Finland: SCT NRC Finland collaborated with Univ. of Eastern Finland

Finish version of the Foundation course (Now live), Include course in Master's degree programme on Health and human services Informatics of Univ. of Eastern Finland

Belgium: Started the French translation of the new/revised SCT Foundation Course

• How is that going, and what recommendations would you have to share with others?

### Member Reports SNOMED CT education priorities and requirements?

- Finland: Providing free courses and increasing understanding of SNOMED CT.
- **Belgium:** Priority goes to the eHR software vendors.

Plan to define education goals and priorities in the following roadmap :

- Translation of official SNOMED CT courses.
- Integrating SNOMED CT in the curriculum for healthcare students at the universities.
- Creating education movies/online courses for different disciplines and end users (clinicians, vendors, ...).

- Organization of webinars for software vendors? (once have a SNOMED CT implementation specialist in the Belgian NRC).

- Cyprus: Slides and/or document (basic) in Greek language.
- Australia: Implementers that are interested in terminology services.

### Member Reports SNOMED CT education priorities and requirements?

- Argentina: Different levels of implementation and strategies for migrating existing systems to SNOMED CT.
- Canada: Technical support using SNOWSTORM. Integration of tools to simplify processes. Collaborative editing. Support vendors in implementing standards.
- Netherlands: A big priority training terminologists. Also supporting implementation.
   Another aim is to make SNOMED more known around people (especially health care providers) that are not necessarily already IT engaged. So that there will be more requests to use it.

#### SNOMED International

#### Member Reports Feedback on SNOMED CT eLearning Experiences?

- Cyprus: Auditing the new Foundation course (module A).
- Argentina: Our NRC finds very useful the eLearning courses and pathways. We use them to train new employees and also as an input for our own training materials.
- Finland: New Foundation Course is good and it will support students more than previous one, because videos are shorter, there are more exercises that clarify the subject.
- Australia: Had some people complete the existing foundation course their interest is more regarding the content so they would have liked to have seen some more information about it. They also commented that some of the questions in the final assessment were ambiguous. However overall, it was a worthwhile course.

#### Member Reports Feedback on SNOMED CT eLearning Experiences?

 Netherlands:- Elearning platform has really nice look and feel, easy to navigate and interactive. Authoring course level 1: Some improvements suggested on presentations length and performance. Some comments on text on handouts, feedback given on assessments and exam. Very much appreciated that there was a low barrier to ask questions and that the responses to those questions were quick and elaborate.

Authoring course level 2: good course!, less videos and a lot of 'e-books' which was really nice to work with. Nice that the assessments were partly automatized so that you get immediate feedback, and it saves time for the team of SNOMED International.

Also assessments that were manually checked good feedback was provided.

Lesson about regularly checking the editorial guide and the templates was very valuable. it is good to be aware to keep checking new guidelines and changes, because it is developing all the time.

#### Member Reports What are the languages required for education to drive adoption of SNOMED CT in your region?

Finland: Finnish, English

Belgium: Dutch and French

Cyprus: Greek

Argentina: Spanish

Canada: French, English

Denmark: English

Netherlands: Dutch, English

#### Member Reports Potential Education Delivery Partners

**Finland:** Yes, have University of Eastern Finland (UEF) that manage education courses of SNOMED CT. There are some discussions with other universities, who teach pathology, that they could also receive credits for completing the SNOMED CT course.

**Belgium:** Already collaborating with several universities (Faculty of Translation) for the translation of (parts of) the Foundation Course in Dutch and French. The goal is to have the SNOMED CT Foundation Course translated by 2022 Q2. Within the next roadmap we definitely want to set up collaboration with universities (Faculty of Medicine) in order to have them incorporate relevant SNOMED CT courses in Dutch and French into their education program

**Netherlands:** In touch with the study 'Medical informatics' of Amsterdam University Medical Center. We have discussed them possibly hosting the Foundation Course (nationalized to the Dutch situation). They were interested, but only for the new version of the Foundation Course. So, we are waiting until that version is published and will reconnect again to investigate the possibilities.

#### Member Reports Topics, you would like us to discuss

**Belgium:** Education partnership possibilities, e.g. an NRC or university hosting an official SCT course

**Canada:** With the wish to use International Patient Summary (IPS), many interoperability issues arose. Are there other countries that are facing challenges and what is the plan to address these?



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### **E-Learning Courses**

- SNOMED CT courses are all free for SNOMED International Members
- Fees for certification exams (50% discount for Members)
- Members 1 free certification exam per year for each type of certification exam
- Increased demand for courses book early
- Authoring Courses
  - Currently, course seats are offered by a first come, first served basis so book early (Capped)
  - Places retained for NRC's
