## Purpose

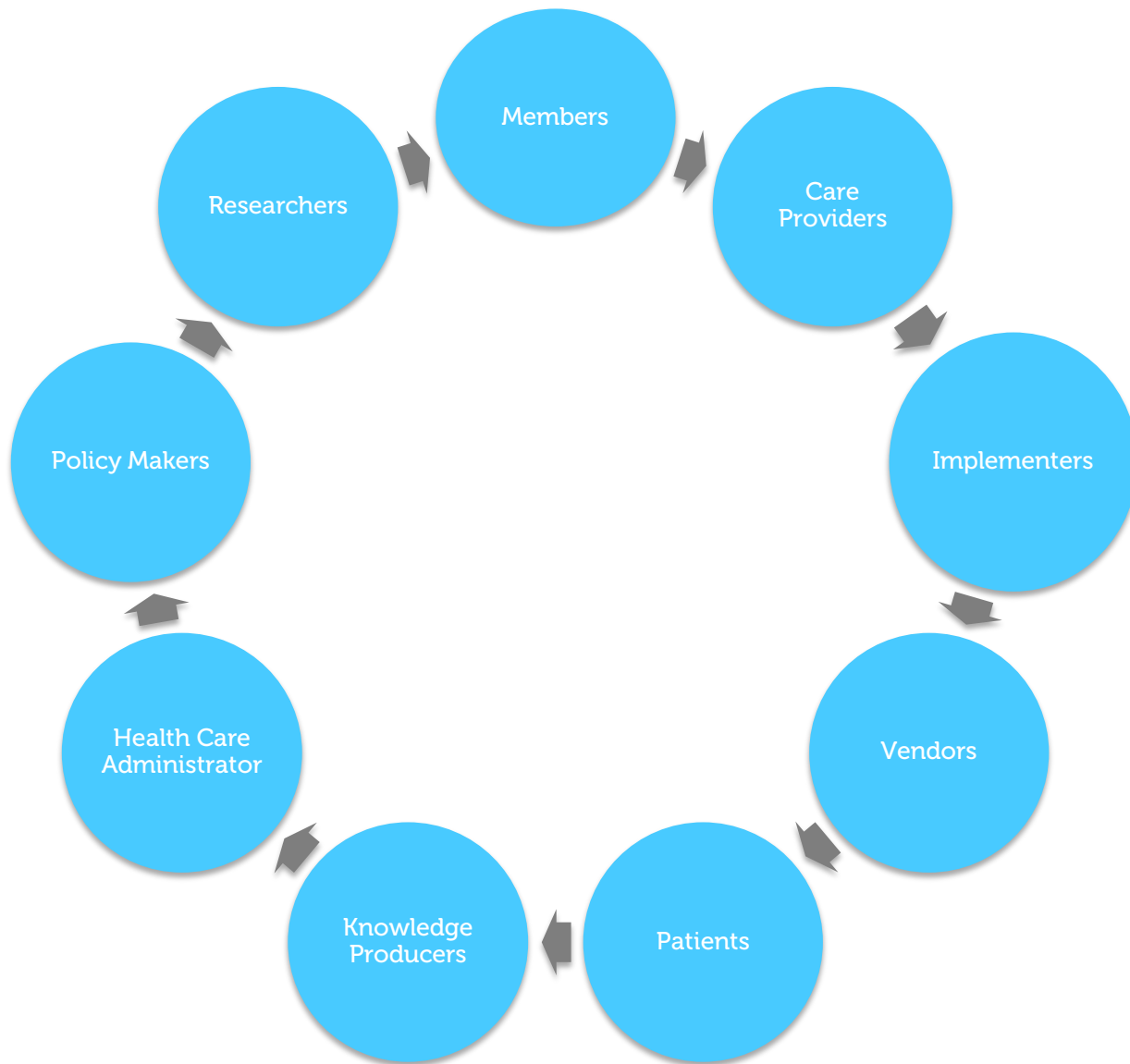

It should be an international endeavor, utilizing the skills and efforts of experts from around the world.

IHTSDO was founded on that principle. In 2007, nine charter nations established IHTSDO for the purposes of building and strengthening SNOMED CT, other health terminologies and related terminology products, and developing, maintaining, promoting and enabling the uptake and correct use of its terminology products in health systems, services and products around the world.

It is a strong and proud membership organization, serving and responding to the needs of its Member countries.

## Who Are Our Customers and Stakeholders?

SNOMED CT enables accurate and targeted access to relevant information, reducing costly duplications and errors.

Patients can be more proactive in managing their own health.

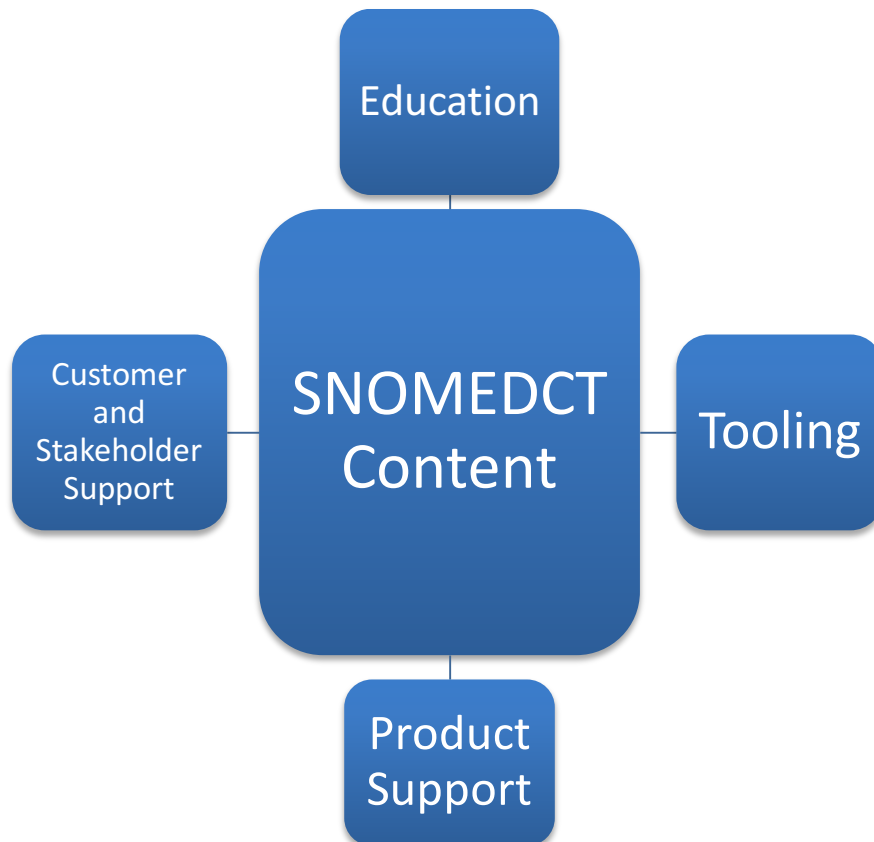
### Knowledge Producers
