

Title: Introduction to SNOMED CT®

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Audience

This introductory course is for anyone interested in acquiring a broad understanding of SNOMED CT[®]. The class is appropriate for healthcare managers, clinical staff, and system developers who are interested in an overview of the value of SNOMEDT CT[®]. No previous knowledge of SNOMED CT[®] is required, some healthcare background is helpful by not essential.

Learning objectives

This course covers all basic components of SNOMED CT[®] hierarchies, concepts, descriptions, and defining relationships with frequent examples to facilitate understanding.

Outline

Participants will be able to describe the essential components of SNOMED CT[®] and how it is organized. Understand how SNOMED CT[®] fits with an Electronic Health Record. Recognize the benefits of using interoperability standards. Identify uses of SNOMED CT[®] for the representation and retrieval of health information. Understand the avenues for interacting with IHTSDO and how to make suggested changes or improvements.
