

# Accessing releases

Once your account has been reviewed and, if applicable, any invoice has been paid, you will now be able to see that your application has been approved and your account will be in a 'good standing' process.

## Step 1. Access to SNOMED CT

- At this stage you will now have access to download the SNOMED CT International Release by clicking on the 'Releases' link on the top menu or the releases section on your dashboard.

If you would like to apply to access any national Member space that can be found on the MLDS, you can click on the relevant country where you will be asked to provide information used by the member to review your application. Once approved by that country you will have access to the your selected release.
