



Task View - Taxonomy

Steps	Reference
<p>From various components of the Authoring Platform a  View in Taxonomy button can be used to show a concept's position in the taxonomy. Selecting the View in Taxonomy button will load the concept in the Taxonomy pane.</p> <p>Note: only one concept can be viewed at a time and selecting a different concept will replace the Taxonomy tree with that of the newly selected concept.</p>	 <p>The screenshot displays the 'Single Concept Authoring' interface.
