

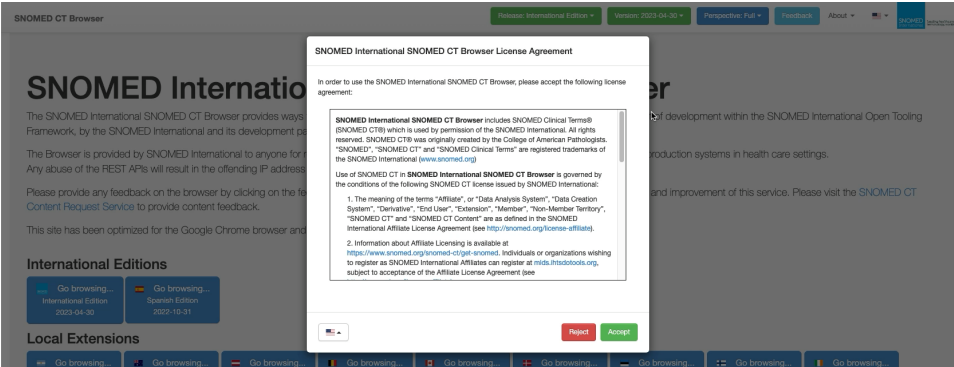
Press Reject to refuse cookie policy consent. If the policy is rejected, the *Notice* header bar will be presented on each subsequent new session first visit to the SCT Browser.
