
• For importing refset members, a user must have a Refset (see Creating a Refset).

Exporting Refset Members

To export a refset follow these steps:

- Log into the tool (https://refset.ihtsdotools.org)
 Select the "Refset" tab or the "Directory" tab.
- Ochoose the Refset you want to export and the Refset Members will be displayed in the table below.







 \circ Click on the "Export refset members" icon



o Fill in the "Export Refset Members" form



o Double click on the downloaded file displayed on your browser frame or open the Downloads directory on your computer to find the exported file.




Importing Refset Members

To import a refset follow these steps:

- Log into the tool (https://refset.ihtsdotools.org)
- Select the "Refset" tab.




- If the refset into which you want to import the refset members is not yet assigned to the user, assign it.
- Choose the "Assigned" accordion
- Select the refset that will contain the refset members. Note: the refset must be an extensional refset.



• There may already be some refset members or the Refset may be empty. Either way, click on the "Import refset members" icon.



• Fill in the "Import Refset Members" form. Select the I/O Handler that matches the input file format. Browse to find and select the input file.



• Click 'Import'.

• View imported refset members in Refset Member table.
