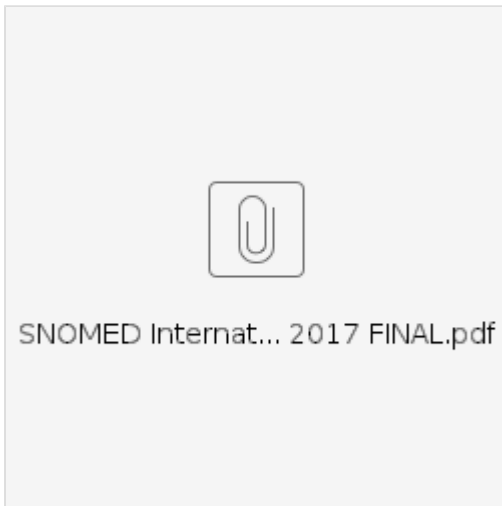


## "Description: James Read Memorial Lecture"
