

expression refinement

The part of a [SNOMED CT expression](#) that applies qualifying details to a [focus concept](#).

Example

- A *spiral fracture of the shaft of humerus* can be represented by an [expression](#) in which the [concept](#) *fracture of humerus* is made more specific by the addition of a refinements containing attributes that more precisely indicate the location and morphology.
