A [concept](#) that has a direct [|](#) is a [subtype relationship](#) to a specified [concept](#).

Notes

Example

- The figure below shows an example hierarchy in which [concept](#) C has two *subtype children*, F and G.

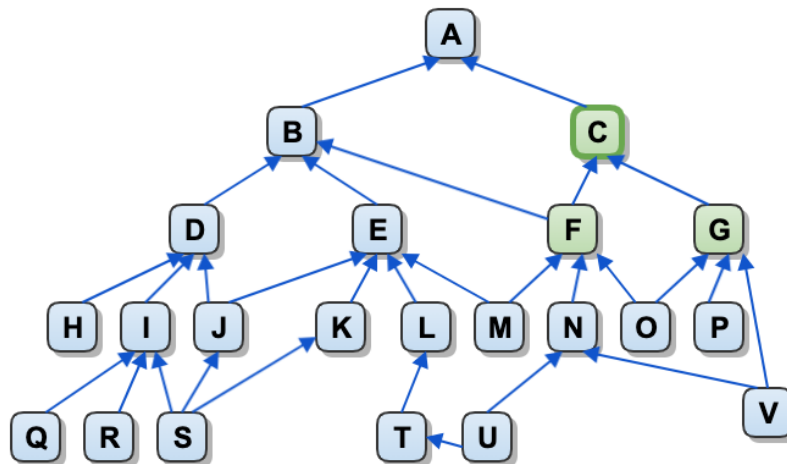


Figure 1: Hierarchy Illustration - Subtype children
